PPIS' Response to Announcement of Singapore Entering Phase 3

1. PPIS supports the gradual easing of restrictions as announced by Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong on Monday. PM Lee announced that Singapore will enter Phase 3 of its reopening on 28 Dec 2020.
2. We are also heartened by the news that Covid-19 vaccines will be available for all Singaporeans and long-term residents and that these vaccines will be free. PPIS hopes that members of our community will go for the vaccination when the time comes.
