As-Salaam

As-Salaam is a Specialist Centre with more than 25 years of experience in working with Malay-Muslim single parent families.

In 2015, As-Salaam achieved a new milestone by being appointed as a Divorce Support Specialist Agency (DSSA) by the Ministry of Social and Family Development (MSF). Through specialised training, our staff were further equipped with knowledge and skills in handling divorce issues to provide the support needed for families that have been divorced or are currently going through a divorce.

As a DSSA, we offer counselling and other programmes such as Parenting PACT and Children in Between (CiB) for parents and their young children to better cope with the impact of divorce and be aware of available resources in the community.

At As-Salaam, we believe that life is a journey – one that is full of tribulations. Each tribulation provides for an opportunity and

potential for families to grow from strength to strength. When families are able to overcome these life challenges, they move on positively and become stronger together.

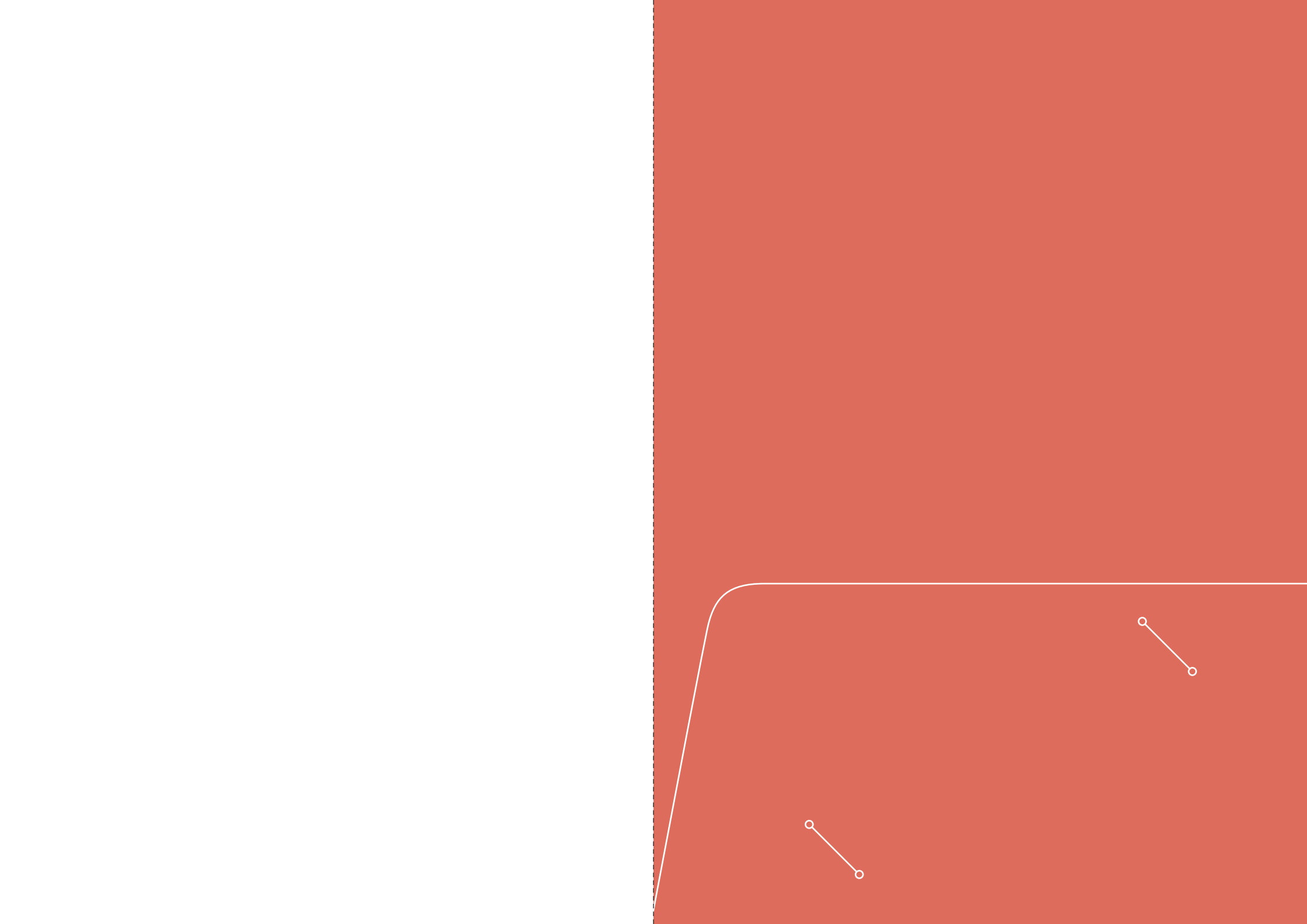
